Dr. Caine aims to understand brain mechanisms underlying abnormal behaviors and to discover improved medications for psychiatric disorders. Throughout his career, he has pursued two lines of investigation: pharmacological mechanisms underlying stimulant medications and stimulant abuse, and neural mechanisms underlying stimulant-induced psychosis and antipsychotic therapeutics. Dr. Caine has received numerous awards, including one from William Jefferson Clinton at the White House.
